Public Works

Winter time is upon us, so here are a couple of reminders about the cold weather:

- Make sure any outside hoses have been disconnected from your hose bibs. Water in the hose will prevent your tap from draining properly, which may cause your tap to freeze and break.
- Did you shut off your sprinkler system for the winter? On extremely cold days when temperatures never get above freezing and night time dips into the teens or lower, we strongly recommend that you leave a small trickle of water running inside the house to prevent freeze ups. Especially if you know that you have had problems in the past.

Snow removal season is a wonderful time for everyone to practice a little patience and understanding.



- Please remember that it is unlawful for you to put snow that falls on your property onto someone else's, including the road or sidewalk.
- Try to not leave your vehicles on the street any longer than is necessary. Most of our streets are pretty narrow and when we get too many cars on the streets it makes it very difficult to remove the snow safely and effectively.
- On trash days please take your empty cans in as soon as possible. They also make it difficult to remove snow effectively.

There are no two storms exactly alike. With that being said, the number of times the plow truck passes in front of your home will be different during each storm event. We strive to be as efficient as possible. Over all, Sunset has great residents and we really appreciate the support and help you give. Sometimes we just need friendly reminders. Thank you in advance for your understanding.

Air Force to Offer Air Sampling In Sunset

Hill Air Force Base has begun its annual indoor air sampling program for the 2017 sampling season. The purpose of the program is to test the air inside homes near areas of groundwater contamination from Hill and determine if chemical vapors from the groundwater are entering homes. If vapors are found above established action levels, the Air Force will take action to prevent those vapors from entering the home. The drinking water has not been affected by the contamination.

The sampling is free, as are all future remediation efforts. To check your eligibility for sampling, please call 385-474-8577. Information about the program, including maps showing the areas eligible for sampling, are available at www.hill.af.mil/IAP.
