



Here is what you need to know about recycling Christmas items. Like Boxes, Bows, Cards, Ribbons, Wrapping Paper, Lights, Tinsel, Tape and Trees.

## YES To Cardboard Boxes, Cards, and Some Wrapping Papers.

You can recycle Cardboard boxes, Cards, and Wrapping Paper. As long as the Cards and Wrapping Paper are NOT covered with additives like metallic flakes, colored shapes, glitter, and plastics. Foil, metallic, and heavily laminated wrapping paper should also be thrown away and NOT Recycled. The bottom line is when in doubt throw it in the trash. Because polluting the recycling stream takes time to clean and costs money.

## NO To Bows, Ribbons, Lights, Tinsel, Tape, Trees and Styrofoam.

You can NOT Recycle Bows, Ribbons, Lights, Tinsel, Tape, Trees, and Styrofoam in the ACE Recycling Stream. Bows, Ribbons, Tinsel, and Tape are trash. However, Lights, Styrofoam, and other hard-to-recycle items can be recycled by going to www.utahrecyclingalliance.org and taking them to one of their Hard-to-Recycle Events. Most cities will have special drop-off locations for your Christmas Tree. Just visit your city's website for more information.
